A volunteer coordinator manages an organization's volunteer program, including recruiting, training, and supervising volunteers.

Other responsibilities include:

- Recruiting: Finding people with skills, interests, or goals that align with the organization's mission or cause
- Screening: Assist in ensuring that ED completes background checks or interviews to assess potential volunteers
- Training: Providing orientation and training sessions for volunteers
- Placing: Assigning volunteers to different roles based on their qualifications
- Maintaining records: Keeping accurate records of volunteers
- Managing: Overseeing the management and retention of volunteers
- Evaluating: Assessing volunteer positions, descriptions, and training to ensure they meet current needs
- Communicating: Designing and delivering communication to internal and external constituents
- Recognizing and Supporting: Recommending and executing opportunities to recognize volunteers
  while providing support for strategic and operational projects.

Some skills that may be useful for a volunteer coordinator include:

- Excellent computer and flyer design skills
- Enthusiasm and teamwork focus with strong customer service orientation
- Well organized and detail oriented
- Effective leadership and team building skills
- Self-motivated and able to work independently
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills with an ability to multi-task
